First of all, we would like to announce that our campus will double in size with the signing of the agreement for unit next to our existing unit. It will be ready by the end of the year to welcome the new intake in 2019.



Outstanding Student Achievements

We are proud with our students' achievements beyond their normal classrooms, having participated in various competitions. Further to our students' success in the **World Maths Day 2018** having ranked globally at **10th position (for Year 7)** and **8th position (for Year 8)**, our students also performed well in the Beaver Computational Thinking Competition 2018. This online competition, held in more than 36 countries across the globe, assesses one's application of problem solving skills using computer science techniques. In Malaysia, there were more than 6,000 participants from various types of schools and learning centres. We are pleased to note that **Axcel Campus is the only centre among international schools or centres with international school syllabus in Malaysia that achieved Gold, Silver and Bronze medal recipients in the Cadet (Form 1 & 2) category.** The Gold medal denotes top 1.6% while Bronze is top 10% of the participants in the category. Another nine of our students were awarded Honorable Mention or top 50% of their category.

Asia Leadership Youth Camp



Four of our Year 10 students were chosen to participate in the Asia Leadership Youth Camp, co-organised by Centre of Asia Leadership and Sunway International School. This 5-day residential "Experiencing Harvard" programme exposed participants to varied experiential learning opportunities and maximising leadership potential. The teaching fellows of Harvard University advocated that times have changed

and students must realise that getting the best grades do not necessarily guarantee a place in their university of choice. Nowadays, top universities are choosing students based on a holistic approach, emphasizing on core competencies like communication, practical reasoning, creativity, character and commitment to society apart from good grades.

Workshop - Financial Intelligence

We strongly believe that financial intelligence is a core life skill in the modern society. We had the privilege of a former Executive Director in an international bank to conduct a two-day financial intelligence workshops for different levels. For Level 2, the students were taught through playing the Cashflow 101 game to experience hands-on fun learning while further harness their knowledge on money and finance. The workshop created a forum for students to use the knowledge to make more informed choices and decisions about money in their everyday life.



Field Trip



Our Year 7 students had a full day field trip to Sunway University. There, they attended two workshops on Creativity and Business Communication. At the same time, students visited the university's state-of-the-art library and other facilities including the extensive and well-equipped science labs. With early exposure in visiting a university, the students are motivated to put in a more focused effort towards their tertiary education.

We continue to stress the importance of having a proactive attitude and persistent effort in supporting a student's quest to embrace knowledge and life skills.
